

ORDINANCE NO. 1084

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF AIRCRAFT ON THE WATERWAYS OF THE CITY OF LACEY AND ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 9.57 TO THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the taking off and landing of aircraft on a waterway requires that there be sufficient water surface area containing no other craft, water vehicles, persons, or other objects obstructing that water surface area, and

WHEREAS, there are no waterways within the City of Lacey meeting the above restrictions;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

There is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code a new chapter entitled Aircraft on City Waterways to read as follows:

9.57.010 Definitions.

- (1) "Aircraft" for the purposes of this chapter means any contrivance now known, or hereafter invented, used or designed for navigation of or flight in the air, and equipped for landing upon or taking off from water.
- (2) "Person" for the purposes of this chapter means any individual, regardless of age or sex, firm, partnership, corporation, company, or association.
- (3) "Waterway" for the purposes of this chapter means any lake, pond, river, creek, stream, or other fresh water body of water.

9.57.020 Aircraft on Waterways -- Prohibited.

It is unlawful for any person operating an aircraft to land or take off from any waterway located within the City of Lacey.

9.57.030 Violation -- Penalty.

Any person violating any provision of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor.
