

ORDINANCE NO. 117

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 77 OF THE CITY OF LACEY BY AMENDING SECTION 1302 (b) AND TABLE NO. 5-C OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1967 EDITION, VOLUME 1, AND APPENDIX THEREIN, RELATING TO FIRE-RESISTIVE CONSTRUCTION OF GROUP H OCCUPANCIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1302 (b) of the Uniform Building Code, 1967 Edition, Volume 1, and Appendix therein, be amended to read:

"1302 (b) Special Provisions. Group H Occupancies more than two stories in height or having more than three thousand (3,000) square feet of floor area above the first floor shall be of not less than one-hour fire-resistive construction throughout. All other Group H Occupancies shall have a minimum of three-quarter-hour fire-resistive interior construction throughout."

Section 2. That Table 5-C of the Uniform Building Code, 1967 Edition, Volume 1, and Appendix therein, for Group H Occupancies using Type V N Construction shall be amended by adding footnote No. 4, to read:

"All interior construction of walls and ceilings shall be not less than three-quarter-hour fire-resistive construction."

Section 3. This ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and the same shall go into effect immediately after its passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
