

ORDINANCE NO. 122

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF THE ALLEY LYING NORTH OF LOTS 20 THROUGH 24, BLOCK 33 OF VACATED NEW STATE ADDITION, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF IN THE CITY OF LACEY, COUNTY OF THURSTON, STATE OF WASHINGTON; RESERVING EASEMENTS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the portion of alley lying North of Lots 20 through 24, Block 33 of vacated New State Addition, according to the plat thereof, be, and the same is, hereby vacated: Provided, however, that the City reserves easements for existing facilities of Puget Sound Power and Light Company and Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company in the vacated area; and Provided Further, however, that the City reserves easements for existing or future sewers or water lines in the vacated area; and Provided Further, however, that the City reserves an access easement over said vacated area for fire protection purposes.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its passage and publication.
