

ORDINANCE NO. 130

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY AMENDING THE WEIGHT LOAD RESTRICTIONS ON SOUTHEAST 46th STREET (HERMAN ROAD); TEMPORARILY AMENDING PORTIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 27, SECTION 1, RELATING THERETO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 27, Section 1, of the City of Lacey, is temporarily amended as follows:

From this date until revoked by ordinance, the weight load restrictions for Southeast 46th Street (Herman Road) from Lacey Boulevard to the southerly City Limits shall be one-half (1/2) of the weight load restrictions as now set out in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 27. Those portions of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 27 adopting those sections of RCW Chapter 46.44 relating to weight load restrictions are amended by the terms of this ordinance for the term of this ordinance; provided, however, that these amended restrictions do not apply to emergency vehicles, school buses and vehicles carrying school supplies.

Section 2. This ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the Citizens of Lacey and shall go into effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
