

ORDINANCE NO. 1305

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PANHANDLING BY SOLICITING PERSONS AND VEHICLES ENTERING OR EXITING FROM PUBLIC STREETS, AMENDING SECTION 5.21.030 OF THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE AND ADOPTING A SUMMARY FOR PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, in order to protect the safety of the traveling public, the City has previously prohibited soliciting persons who are in a vehicle on the street and, the Council finds that it is further necessary to restrict the solicitation of people in vehicles on those driveways providing access to and from such streets, where the driveway is open to the general public,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Section 5.21.030 of the Lacey Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:


5.21.030 Place of Panhandling--Violation. It shall be unlawful for any person to panhandle when the person solicited is in any of the following places within the City limits of Lacey, Washington:

- A. At any bus or train stops;
- B. In any public transportation vehicle or facility;
- C. In any vehicle on ~~the a~~ street or on a driveway providing ingress or egress to a street where such driveway is open to the general public;
- D. Within fifty feet of any automated teller machine (ATM);
- E. On private property, unless the panhandler is in physical possession of ~~has-express written~~ permission from the owner or lawful occupant thereof.
