

ORDINANCE NO. 151

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1.B (1) OF ORDINANCE NO. 118 PASSED SEPTEMBER 25, 1969, RELATING TO CHARGES FOR SERVICE CONNECTIONS TO THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 B of Ordinance No. 118, passed on September 25, 1969, is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. STANDARD SERVICE CONNECTION:

(1) The Construction of a standard new service connection by the City of Lacey for water shall include all labor, pipe and fittings up to the property line. The charges for the labor and materials, including the meter and its installation, for a standard service connection shall be as follows:

<u>TYPE OF SERVICE:</u>	<u>METER SIZE:</u>	<u>CONNECTION CHARGE:</u>
Single Residence	5/8 x 3/4"	150.00
Commercial	5/8 x 3/4"	150.00
Commercial	3/4"	175.00
Commercial	1"	200.00
Commercial	1 1/4"	225.00
Commercial	1 1/2"	250.00
Commercial	2"	300.00

Over 2" meter - the charge shall be the costs of labor and material, plus fifteen (15%) per cent.

1st Read - 8/23/20  
2nd Read - 8/24/20


Where the customer already has a connection and requests an additional connection or a new connection, the charge shall be the costs of labor and material, plus fifteen (15%) per cent.

On connections for sprinkling only, the charge shall be the costs of the material and labor, plus fifteen (15%) per cent.

No water connection shall be made until the person desiring the same has signed an application at the office of the City of Lacey, Water Department, and paid the charges imposed herein.

Section 2. This amendatory ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Lacey and shall go into effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication in the manner prescribed by law.


