

ORDINANCE NO. 172

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF LACEY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR, 1971, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY:

Section 1. That the preliminary budget of the City of Lacey for the fiscal year, 1971, as revised by the City Council, and each and every item thereof is hereby incorporated by reference and adopted as the final budget of the City of Lacey for the fiscal year, 1971, and the City Clerk is directed to print said budget for distribution as provided by law. The totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for each fund and the aggregate totals for all such funds combined in said budget are as follows:


Section 2. The salaries and wages set forth in detail in this budget, on file in the Office of the City Clerk, and by this reference incorporated herein, constitute the appropriations for salaries and wages and no officer or employee shall be paid in excess of the sum appropriated for the position which he fills except pursuant to ordinance amending said appropriation passed under authority of RCW 35.33.107. In the event the amounts appropriated by this budget ordinance exceed the amounts set out in any compensation ordinance for elective officers, the amounts set out herein shall control and amend said compensation ordinance to the contrary.

Section 3. This ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.
