

ORDINANCE NO. 26

CITY OF LACEY

An ordinance fixing compensation to be paid the Municipal Court Judge and Judge Pro-tem of the City of Lacey; providing compensation for bookkeeping expenses; and providing for the reimbursement of expenses.

The City Council of the City of Lacey Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. The Municipal Court Judge shall receive annually a salary in the sum of Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1200.00), the same to be paid in equal monthly installments on the last day of each calendar month.

Section 2. The Municipal Court Judge shall receive an additional allowance, to compensate for bookkeeping expenses, in the amount of \$100.00 per month, payable on the last day of each calendar month; Provided that, the fine fixed by the Municipal Court Judge shall provide for the assessment of Two Dollars (\$2.00) costs to be assessed on each case tried to defray said bookkeeping expenses; Provided Further that, said costs assessed shall be paid over to the City Treasurer by the Municipal Court Judge.

Section 3. The Municipal Court Judge Pro-tem shall be compensated Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each Court Session over which he presides and said amount shall be deducted from the regular Municipal Court Judge's salary for that month; Provided that for a two (2) week period during each year the Municipal Court Judge may have the Municipal Court Judge Pro-tem preside over the regular court sessions and during said two (2) week period the Municipal Court Judge's salary shall not be reduced by the amount of the salary paid to the Municipal Court Judge Pro-tem.

Section 4. The Municipal Court Judge shall receive an additional allowance not to exceed Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars in any one year, for the purchase of office and courtroom equipment, books and office supplies and stationery, and employment of secretarial help, upon presentation of a claim therefor after allowance and approval thereof, by resolution of the City Council. Title to office equipment and books shall be vested and remain in the City of Lacey.


Section 5. That the compensation herein provided shall be payable as hereinabove stated for all official duties performed on or after the 1st day of April, 1967.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.


