

ORDINANCE NO. 273

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SEWER SERVICE CHARGES FOR NON-RESIDENTIAL ESTABLISHMENTS, AMENDING SECTION 13.16.060 OF THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 13.16.060 of the Lacey Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.16.060 Basic service charge. The "basic sewer service charge" of Lacey shall be four dollars and fifty cents per month per equivalent residential unit; provided, that those nonresidential establishments consuming in excess of 4,500 cubic feet of water (5 ERU's) per month shall be charged at the rate of three dollars and ten cents per equivalent residential unit for such excess consumed.

Section 2. This amendment shall apply to the computation of sewer charges for all consumption of water subsequent to November 30, 1972.

Section 3. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare and safety and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.
