ORDINANCE No. 28

AN ORDINANCE relating to abandoned iceboxes, defining offenses, and providing penalties.

The City Council of the City of Lacey do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Abandoned iceboxes--Failure to remove locks--Unlawful.
It shall be unlawful to leave or have accessible to children any abandoned, unused or discarded refrigerators, ice boxes or like containers of a capacity of one and one-half cubic feet or more, unless all doors thereon may be readily opened from the inside thereof or have been removed therefrom and unless all locks or locking devices have been removed therefrom.

Section 2. Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by both such fine or imprisonment.

This ordinance adopted this 20th day of April, 1967.
