

ORDINANCE NO. 283

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A ONE PER CENT EXCISE TAX AGAINST THE MARKET VALUE OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF LACEY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Lacey is now engaged in conjunction with the Cities of Olympia and Tumwater in the operation of a public transportation system within the City of Lacey, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lacey in accordance with the authority contained in RCW 35.58.273 desires to levy and collect an excise tax on motor vehicles in the manner and in the amount provided by said law, Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby levied an excise tax in the amount of one per cent of the fair market value of every motor vehicle owned by a resident of the City of Lacey, for the privilege of using said motor vehicle within the City of Lacey; provided, however, in no event shall the tax on any such vehicle be less than One Dollar (\$1.00) and, subject to the provisions of RCW 82.44.150(2), the amount of such tax shall be credited against the amount of the excise tax levied by the State of Washington pursuant to RCW 82.44.020.

Section 2. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare and safety and
