ORDINANCE No. 32

AN ORDINANCE relating to petit larceny; defining terms; and providing penalties.

The City Council of the City of Lacey do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Petit larceny defined--Penalty for violations.
Every person who, within the City of Lacey, steals or unlawfully obtains, appropriates, brings into the City of Lacey, buys, sells, receives, conceals or withholds in any manner the personal goods and property of another, under the value of seventy-five dollars, shall be deemed guilty of petit larceny, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment in the city jail for not more than 6 months, or by such fine and imprisonment.
