ORDINANCE No. 34

AN ORDINANCE relating to the sale or furnishing of cigarettes to minors; defining terms; stating purpose; and providing penalties.

The City Council of the City of Lacey do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Construction. This entire ordinance shall be deemed an exercise of the police power of the City of Lacey for the protection of the economic welfare, health, peace and morals of the people of the City of Lacey, and all of its provisions shall be liberally construed for the accomplishment of that purpose.

Section 2. Person defined. The word "person" wherever used in this ordinance, shall be held and construed to mean and include natural persons, firms, co-partnerships and corporations, and all association of natural persons, whether acting by themselves or by a servant, agent, or employee.


Section 3. Sales to minors unlawful. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, barter, furnish or give away directly or indirectly to any minor, under eighteen years of age, any cigar, cigarette, cigarette paper or wrapper, or any substitute for either, or tobacco in any form, or to procure for or to persuade, advise, counsel or compel any minor under said age to smoke cigarettes, or for any minor under said age to smoke any cigarette.

Section 4. Penalty for violations. Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by both such fine or imprisonment.
