

ORDINANCE NO. 41

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF LACEY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF 1945, CHAPTER 128, RCW. Sec. 35.13.130, 35.13.140, and 35.13.150 AND COMPLYING WITH THE PROCEDURE THEREIN SET FORTH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there has been filed with the City Council a petition in writing, signed by the owners of more than seventy-five (75%) percent of the assessed value of the property, according to the assessed valuation of the real property described in the said petition; that the said petition was accompanied by a plat or drawing outlining the boundaries of the property sought to be annexed.

Section 2. That Thursday, May 4, 1967, was set as a date for a public hearing on said petition; that notice of such hearing has been published in the Olympia News, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Lacey; that notice of such hearing was also posted in three (3) public places within the territory proposed for annexation; that the expense of publication and posting of said notices was borne by the signers of the petition.

Section 3. That the following described property, located in the County of Thurston, State of Washington, to wit:

The south 371.8 feet of the north 739.38 feet of that part of Lot 2 of Section 27, Township 18 North, Range 1 West, W.M., lying east of the west line of county road known as Carpenter Road; EXCEPTING therefrom the portion lying in the north 677.64 feet of the west 649.28 feet of said Lot 2. TOGETHER with all shorelands lying in front of, adjacent to and abutting on the south 371.8 feet of the north 739.38 feet of said Lot 2.

be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Lacey, effective the

6th day of June, 1967.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
