

ORDINANCE NO. 42

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO MINORS AND THEIR PARENTS OR GUARDIANS; ESTABLISHING A CURFEW; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS; DEFINING OFFENSES; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Curfew Imposed--Hours--Application--Exceptions. It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of eighteen years to be in or on any public street, highway, road, park, playground, building, or other public place or ground, any public amusement, entertainment, or eating place, or any vacant lot, unoccupied premises, or other unsupervised place in the City of Lacey between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. the following day; Provided, however, that the provisions of this ordinance do not apply to a minor accompanied by his/or her parent or legal guardian, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his/or her parent or legal guardian and said legitimate business includes returning directly home from any school function, work, recreational activity, or formally supervised recreation.

Section 2. Minor--Penalty for Violation. Any minor under the age of eighteen years violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be dealt with in accordance with juvenile court laws and procedure, and if remanded for Lacey Police Court prosecution or other prosecution as an adult, shall be punished upon conviction by a fine of not more than \$500.00 dollars or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. Parents--Not to Permit Violation--Penalty. Any parent or other person having the legal care or custody of a minor under the age of eighteen years who knowingly permits such minor to violate any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 dollars or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by both such fine and imprisonment.
