





ORDINANCE NO. 44

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR EMERGENCY FUNDS FOR THE LACEY POLICE DEPARTMENT. THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City of Lacey is a newly formed municipality having no previous budget upon which to make a proper forecast of expenditures and income for the year 1967, and

WHEREAS, said city was not incorporated on the first Monday in October of the year 1966 as provided by the final hearing on the adoption of budgets, RCW 35.33.070, and

WHEREAS, the revenue of the City of Lacey has exceeded the forecast of May 4, 1967, and expenditures for some departments have not been adequately forecast, and it is imperative that the Police Department of the City of Lacey be provided with the sum of Three Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$3,000.00), and the same is necessary for the public health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Lacey, and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the attached emergency budget be voted upon at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Lacey on the 1st day of June, 1967.
