

ORDINANCE 464

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SPECIAL FUND OF THE CITY KNOWN AS THE "OPERATING FUND OF THE JOINT ANIMAL CONTROL COMMISSION" PURSUANT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR JOINT ANIMAL CONTROL OPERATIONS; PROVIDING FOR REVENUES TO AND EXPENDITURES FROM SAID FUND AND ADDING A NEW CHAPTER TO THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that there is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code a new chapter, 3.34 to read as follows:

"Section 3.34.010. There is hereby created a special fund within the funds and budget of the City of Lacey to be known and designated as the Operating Fund of the Joint Animal Control Commission pursuant to that certain intergovernmental agreement for joint animal control operations between the City of Lacey, the City of Olympia, the City of Tumwater, the Town of Bucoda and Thurston County.

"Section 3.34.020. There shall be deposited in said fund all revenues received from the parties to the intergovernmental agreement for joint animal control operations and all revenues received for the payment of services or from other sources for the purpose of animal control or animal shelter activities.


"Section 3.34.030. Expenditures from the operating fund shall be made only for animal shelter and animal shelter control activities, including the actual administrative costs and overhead of the City of Lacey incurred pursuant to its obligations set forth

in the intergovernmental agreement for joint animal control operations."


