

ORDINANCE 497

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CITY OFFICERS AND SETTING THE AMOUNTS OF FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE BONDS, AMENDING SECTIONS 2.12.010, 2.12.020, ADDING NEW CHAPTERS 2.22, 2.26 AND REPEALING SECTIONS 2.16.030 AND 2.48.040 OF THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.12.010 of the Lacey Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Salary. The city attorney shall receive annually a salary to be paid in equal ~~monthly~~ installments ~~on-the-last-day-of-each~~ ~~calendar-month.~~"

Section 2. Section 2.12.020 of the Lacey Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Additional allowance for supplies. The city attorney shall receive an additional allowance, for the purchase of office equipment, books and office supplies and employment of secretarial ~~help-upon-presentation-of-a-claim-therefor-after-allowance-and~~ ~~approval-thereof-by-resolution-of-the-city-council.~~ Title to office equipment and books shall be vested and remain in the city."

Section 3. There is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code a new chapter, 2.22, to read as follows:

"2.22.010. The director of parks and recreation for the City of Lacey shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the city manager.

"2.22.020. The director of parks and recreation shall be responsible for and in charge of the Parks and Recreation Department of the city."

Section 4. There is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code a new chapter, 2.26, to read as follows:

"2.26.010. All officers of the City of Lacey before entering upon the performance of their duties shall take an oath or affirmation for the faithful performance of their duties. The city manager, city attorney, city clerk/treasurer, director of public works, director of parks and recreation and chief of police shall furnish annually an official bond conditioned on the honest and faithful performance of their official duties. The amount of said bonds shall be as follows:

"City Manager	\$ 25,000.00
"City Attorney	1,000.00
"City Clerk/Treasurer	100,000.00
"Director of Public Works	25,000.00
"Director of Parks and Recreation	25,000.00
"Chief of Police	1,000.00

The premiums on such bonds shall be paid by the city."

Section 5. Sections 2.16.030 and 2.48.040 of the Lacey Municipal Code are hereby repealed.
