AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DUTIES OF THE MAYOR, MAYOR PRO TEMPORE AND CITY COUNCIL AND AMENDING CHAPTERS 2.09 and 2.10 OF THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code, a new section, 2.09.005, to read as follows:
"Mayor. Biennially, at the first meeting of the new council, the members thereof shall choose a chairperson from among their number. The chairperson of the council shall have the title of 'Mayor' and shall preside at meetings of the council. In addition to the powers conferred upon such person as mayor, the person selected shall continue to have all the rights, privileges and immunities of a member of the council. The mayor shall be recognized as the head of the city for ceremonial purposes and by the governor for purposes of military law."

Section 2. There is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code a new section, 2.09.030, to read as follows:
"Mayor Pro Tempore. Biennially, at the first meeting of the new council, the members thereof, by majority vote, shall designate one of their number as mayor pro tempore to serve in the absence or temporary disability of the mayor and to have all the powers of the mayor when so serving."

Section 3. There is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code a new section, 2.10 .005 , to read as follows:
"City Council. The city council shall consist of seven members holding the qualifications and elected pursuant to Title 35A of the Revised Code of Washington and said council shall be the legislative body of the city and have all powers to conduct the affairs of the city as are allowed under the Constitution of the State of Washington and not specifically denied by law or reserved to the city manager."
