

ORDINANCE NO. 54

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 6 ADOPTED JANUARY 19, 1967, ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OR ALTERATION OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 6, City of Lacey, State of Washington, entitled an ordinance relating to the issuance of permits for the construction or alteration of buildings or structures is hereby amended by adding a new section under Sec. 301(b) and the same shall be in addition to all other provisions of the Uniform Building Code as adopted by the City of Lacey, 1964 Edition, Volume 1, said new section to read as follows:

"Prior to the issuance of a building permit for the construction or alteration of any building requiring sanitary or sewage disposal facilities of any kind, the applicant shall first obtain from the City of Lacey Buildings Section an "Application for Building Site Approval" which application shall require, but not limited to a sketch of the land; size of structure, type of structure and its location on the particular parcel of land; number of bathrooms; number of bedrooms and if possible the location of the sewage disposal system. The Building Inspector shall approve or reject the same, based on whether or not the proposed structure would comply with standards established by the Thurston-Mason District Board of Health as they relate to sanitary and sewage disposal.

When approved, the applicant may then apply to the City Clerk for the issuance of a "Building Permit". No building permit shall be issued by the City Clerk without a signed application for Building Site Approval.

Any applicant feeling himself aggrieved by the decision of the Building Inspector denying said application may appeal to the City Council. Said appeal shall be in writing and must be filed within thirty (30) days of the denial with the City Clerk and said appeal shall state the grounds upon which the applicant feels himself aggrieved."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
