ORDINANCE 581

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO UTILITY RATES FOR LOW INCOME SENIOR CITIZENS AND LOW INCOME DISABLED CITIZENS, AMENDING SECTION 13.32.032 AND ADDING A NEW SECTION TO THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 13.32.032 of the Lacey Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"There shall be a 15 percent reduction of water charges billed directly to low income senior citizens <u>and low income</u> <u>disabled citizens</u> pursuant to Sections 13.32.020 and 13.32.030. A low income senior citizen for the purposes of this section is defined as a single residential occupant or head of a household who is 62 years of age or older, having a maximum annual income below \$8,000.00 if single and \$11,000.00 if married. <u>A low income</u> <u>disabled citizen for purposes of this section is defined as a single residential occupant or head of a household who has been</u> found to be currently disabled by the Social Security Administration or is a disabled veteran certified by the Veterans' Administration as having a disability of at least 40 percent and having a maximum annual income below \$8,000.00 if single and \$11,000.00 if married."

Section 2. There is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code a new section, 13.16.065, to read as follows:

"There shall be a 15 percent reduction of that portion of sewerage charges levied for the maintenance and operation of the

sewerage collection system of the City of Lacey billed directly to low income senior citizens and low income disabled citizens. A low income senior citizen for the purposes of this section is defined as a single residential occupant or head of a household who is 62 years of age or older, having a maximum annual income below \$8,000.00 if single and \$11,000.00 if married. A low income disabled citizen for purposes of this section is defined as a single residential occupant or head of a household who has been found to be currently disabled by the Social Security Administration orbis a disabled veteran certified by the Veterans' Administration as having a disability of at least 40 percent and having a maximum annual income below \$8,000.00 if single and \$11,000.00 if married."

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective on July 1, 1980.
