

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION and/or OBSTRUCTION OF CITY STREETS BY OTHERS THAN CONTRACTORS FOR THE CITY OR CITY EMPLOYEES, PROVIDING FOR ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Whenever any person, firm or corporation, except city employees or contractors for the city, intends to install any facility in the city right-of-way they shall first obtain a permit therefor. Typical facilities covered by this ordinance are signposts, utility poles, culverts, underground conduits, curbs, sidewalks or any manner of obstruction and/or construction which disturbs the surface of the street, sidewalk or right-of-way .

Section 2. Such person, firm or corporation shall first apply for a permit from the City of Lacey. Said permit application shall be accompanied by detailed plans and specifications covering said construction. Said permit shall require the approval of the City Engineer and if the traveled way will be obstructed, approval of the Police Chief and Fire Chief shall be required.

Section 3. All work shall require restoration of the surface to original or better condition in accordance with the specifications of the Lacey City Engineer.

Section 4. Rules of all Washington State Departments having jurisdiction shall be strictly adhered to with respect to safety, construction methods and other state requirements.


Section 5. A permit fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) shall accompany the application. Should considerable inspection and engineering be required by the City in the opinion of the City Engineer, an estimate of the costs of such inspection and engineering will be furnished the applicant by the Engineer and said estimated amount will become additional application fee.

Section 6. That any person, firm or corporation feeling aggrieved by the decision of the city engineer as to the granting of a permit shall have thirty (30) days within which to make written appeal to the City Clerk of the City of Lacey, setting forth his reason or reasons for such appeal, and such appeal shall be considered and passed upon by the City Council of the City of Lacey, and the results of such consideration forwarded to the appellant within five (5) days of the hearing thereon.


Section 7. Violations of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00 for each violation, or imprisonment for thirty (30) days, or both.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and posting.
