
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16 OF THE CITY OF LACEY AND PROVIDING FOR EXCEPTIONS THERETO

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Ordinance No. 16 of the City of Lacey is hereby amended to insert in Section 2 thereof after the words " of Lacey" the following:

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that it shall not be unlawful to discharge firearms within the city of Lacey in an approved firing range. Firing ranges shall be approved by the chief of police of the city of Lacey and approval or disapproval of a firing range shall be based upon general principles of safety to persons and property surrounding said sites. Any applicant for the approval of a firing range who may feel aggrieved by the decision of the chief of police of the city of Lacey may seek a review of the decision of said chief of police by filing with the clerk of the city of Lacey written Notice of Review within ten (10) days after receiving notice of the decision of the Chief of Police.
