

ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SALE OF DEVICES USED TO CHILL DRINKING GLASSES, COMMONLY KNOWN AS "DE-ICERS", TO MINORS, AND MAKING THE SAME UNLAWFUL, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to sell, barter, trade or make a gift to anyone under the age of twenty-one years, of any device or devices, known by the name of "de-icer" or any other similar name, the same being used as a mechanical and/or chemical means of instantly chilling drinking glasses, such device or devices containing carbon dioxide or other gaseous substances for such purpose.

Sec. 2. This ordinance is promulgated for the protection of minors, and specifically for the protection of the public health and safety of said minors.


Sec. 3. Any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec 4 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
