CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A STRIP OF LAND WITHIN THE CITY (PORTION OF HICKS LAKE ROAD)

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed requesting that the City of Lacey vacate a certain strip of land within the City of Lacey; and

WHEREAS, the city council has held a public hearing on the 22nd day of July, 1982, after due notice, and it appearing at said hearing that the petitioner owns all of the private property abutting the strip of land sought to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, the city council has found that the public will not suffer a detriment by vacation of said strip of land described below if there is reserved an easement for the construction, repair and maintenance for public utilities and services; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

The following described street right-if-way within the City of Lacey, to-wit:

That portion of Hicks Lake Road beginning at its most southerly point and running North 314 feet in the City of Lacey, Thurston County, Washington

is hereby vacated, provided, however, there is hereby reserved from said vacation an easement over, under and through said property

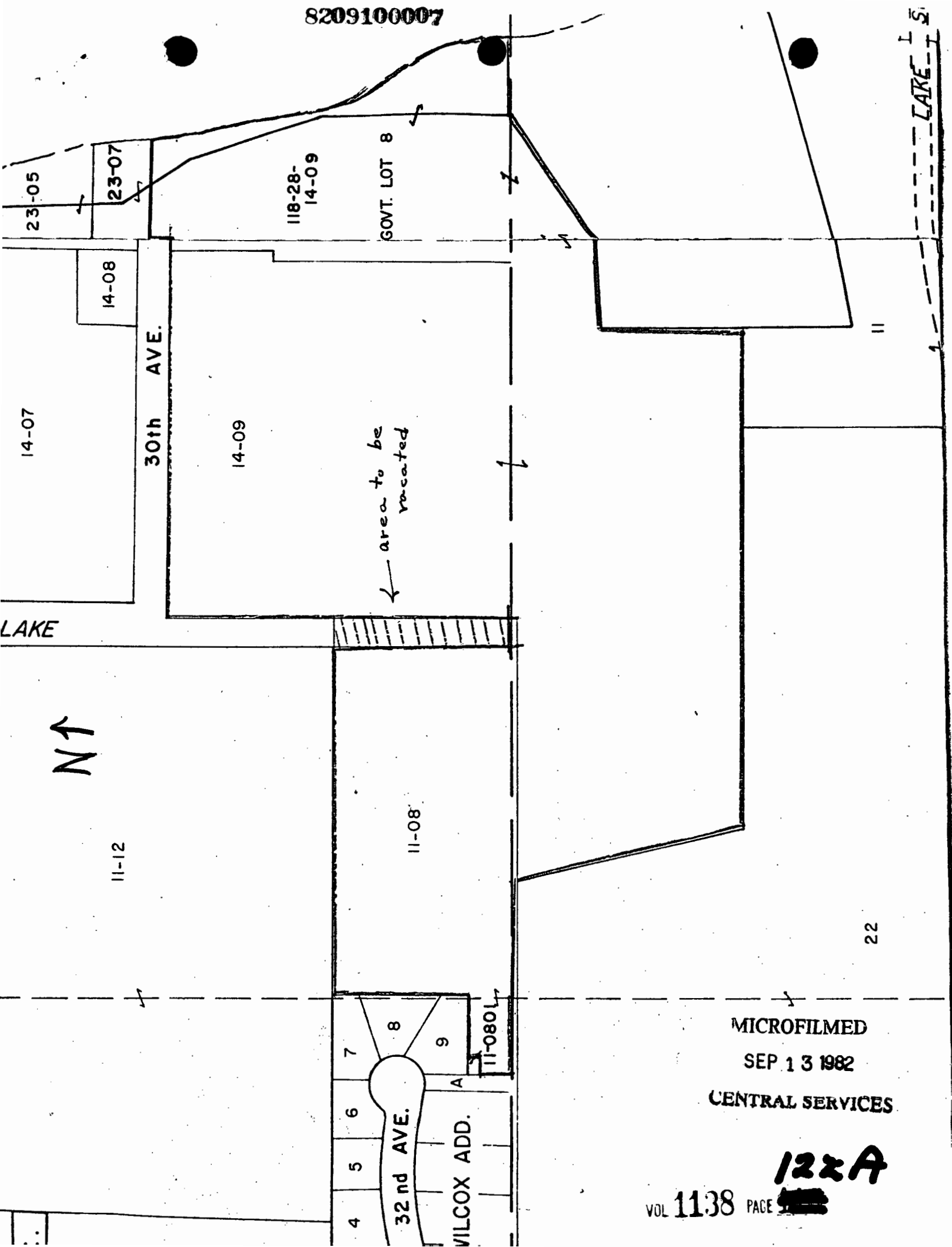
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
