

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING AN ADDITIONAL SALES OR USE TAX PURSUANT TO RCW 82.14.030(2) UPON AND TO BE COLLECTED FROM THOSE PERSONS FROM WHOM THE STATE SALES OR USE TAX IS COLLECTED, FIXING THE RATE AND THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH ADDITIONAL TAX, PROVIDING A SPECIAL INITIATIVE PROCEDURE UPON THE PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE AND ADDING NEW SECTIONS TO THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code a new section 3.04.022 to read as follows:

"There is hereby imposed commencing January 1, 1983, an additional sales or use tax, as the case may be, pursuant to RCW 82.14.030(2), upon every taxable event as defined in RCW 82.14.020, occurring within the City of Lacey. The tax shall be imposed upon and collected from those persons from whom the state sales tax or use tax is collected pursuant to chapters 82.08 and 82.12 RCW."

Section 2. There is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code a new section 3.04.024 to read as follows:

"The rate of the additional tax imposed by section 3.04.022 shall be one-half of one percent of the selling price or value of the article used, as the case may be; PROVIDED, however, that during such period as there is in effect a sales tax or use tax imposed by Thurston County under RCW 82.14.030(2) at a rate equal to or greater than the rate imposed by this section, Thurston County shall receive 15 percent of the tax imposed by section 3.04.022: PROVIDED FURTHER, that during such period as there is in effect a sales tax or use tax imposed by Thurston County under RCW 82.14.030(2) at a rate which is

less than the rate imposed by this section, Thurston County shall receive from the tax imposed by section 3.04.022 that amount of revenues equal to 15 percent of the rate of tax imposed by Thurston County under RCW 82.14.030(2)."

Section 3. This ordinance shall be subject to a "special initiative" (referendum) for a 30 day period commencing at the time of final passage. The number of registered voters needed to sign a petition for such "special initiative" (referendum) shall be 15 percent of the total number of names of persons as listed as registered voters within the city on the day of the last preceding city general election. If such a petition is filed with the city council, the operation of this ordinance shall be suspended until the petition is found insufficient or until this ordinance receives a favorable majority vote by the voters. The procedures for Referendum upon Petition contained in RCW 35A.11.100 shall apply to any such petition.

Section 4. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance or the application of the provisions to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
