

ORDINANCE 682

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MASSAGE BUSINESS AND THE PRACTICE OF MASSAGE AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 86 OF THE CITY OF LACEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 86 of the City of Lacey is hereby amended to read as follows:

"No license pursuant to this ordinance shall be issued to any person or firm not showing proof of a current state massage operator's or massage business license issued pursuant to Chapter 18.108 RCW and no unlicensed person shall be allowed to perform acts for which a license is required on the premises of any massage parlor without having both a current state and city license."

Section 2. Section 13 of Ordinance No. 86 of the City of Lacey is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to massages performed or baths provided in any hospital or at the athletic department of any public or private secondary school or college, or by any person who has been certified or licensed by the state of Washington to perform or provide such services to practice medicine, surgery, drugless therapy, physical therapy, osteopathy, osteopathy and surgery, chiropractic, podiatry, or nursing."

Section 3. Ordinance No. 86 of the City of Lacey as amended herein is hereby readopted in full.
