

ORDINANCE NO. 74

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING EMERGENCY FUNDS FOR THE OFFICE OF CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF LACEY AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE PLANNING COMMISSION ACCOUNT

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City of Lacey is a newly formed municipality having no previous budget upon which to make a proper forecast of expenditures and income for the year, 1967; and

WHEREAS, said City was not incorporated on the first Monday in October of the year, 1966, as provided by RCW 35.33.070 as the date for the final hearing on the adoption of budgets; and

WHEREAS, the revenue of the City of Lacey has exceeded the forecast of May 4, 1967, and expenditures for some departments have not been adequately forecast, and it is imperative that the office of the City Clerk of the City of Lacey be provided with the sum of \$2,100.00, and the same is necessary for the public health, safety and general welfare of the City of Lacey; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists, Now, Therefore,
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY that the attached emergency budget be voted upon at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Lacey on the 21st day of December, 1967.
