

ORDINANCE 746

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HEAVY VEHICULAR TRAFFIC EXCEPT FOR LOCAL DELIVERIES ON COLLEGE STREET S.E. FROM MARTIN WAY TO 37TH AVENUE S.E., PROVIDING THAT VIOLATION OF SAID RESTRICTION SHALL CONSTITUTE A MISDEMEANOR AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 597

WHEREAS, Ordinance 597 prohibited heavy vehicular traffic from Lacey Boulevard to the South city limits and required said traffic to operate in the outside lanes from Martin Way to Lacey Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to further restrict the movement of heavy vehicular traffic over additional portions of College Street S.E.; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 597 of the City of Lacey is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Until further action is taken by the City Council of the City of Lacey, all vehicles with a gross weight in excess of 10,000 pounds are hereby prohibited from traveling on that portion of College Street S.E. from Martin Way to 37th Avenue S.E.; provided, however, that this prohibition shall not apply to those vehicles utilizing said street solely for the purpose of making local deliveries.

Section 3. The Director of Public Works shall place signs on said streets in accordance with the prohibitions and regulations set forth in this ordinance, all in accordance with procedures set forth in Section 10.12.020 of the Lacey Municipal Code.

Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating the terms of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
