

ORDINANCE NO. 76

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PETIT LARCENY; DEFINING TERMS; PROVIDING PENALTIES, and RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 32, PASSED ON APRIL 20, 1967.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Petit Larceny, Defined--Every person who with intent to deprive or defraud the owner thereof commits any act of larceny as defined in Section 9.54.010 of the Revised Code of Washington within the City Limits of the City of Lacey, where the value of such property shall be less than Seventy-Five (\$75.00) Dollars shall be deemed guilty of the crime of petit larceny.

Section 2. Violation, Penalty--Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall rescind and be in place of Ordinance No. 32, passed on the 20th day of April, 1967.

Section 4. That this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the City of Lacey and its existing institutions and shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval and posting.
