

ORDINANCE 765

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO HOLIDAYS FOR CITY EMPLOYEES AND AMENDING SECTION 2.56.180 OF THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that Section 2.56.180 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) The following, and such other days as the city council may fix by resolution, are holidays for all regularly employed full-time employees of the city: the first day of January, commonly called New Year's Day; the ~~twelfth-day-of-February~~ third Monday of January, being the anniversary of the birth of Abraham Lincoln ~~in~~ Martin Luther King, Jr.; the third Monday of February, being celebrated as ~~the-anniversary-of-the-birth-of-George-Washington~~ Presidents' Day; the last Monday of May, commonly known as Memorial Day; the fourth day of July, being the anniversary of the Declaration of Independence; the first Monday in September, to be known as Labor Day; the eleventh day of November, to be known as Veterans Day; the fourth Thursday in November, to be known as Thanksgiving Day; the day immediately following Thanksgiving Day; and the twenty-fifth day of December, commonly called Christmas Day.

"(b) When one of the holidays falls on a Saturday such holiday will be observed on the work day preceding such holiday,

when one of the holidays falls on a Sunday, such holiday will be observed on the next work day following said holiday.

"(c) All regularly employed full-time employees of the city shall be entitled to one paid holiday per calendar year in addition to those specified in this section. Each employee may select the day on which the employee desires to take the additional holiday provided for herein after consultation with and approval of the department head.
