

ORDINANCE 781

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS AND AMENDING SECTION 2.44.070 OF THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF NOTICES OF INFRACTION CALLING FOR THE PAYMENT OF CIVIL FINES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that Section 2.44.070 of the Lacey Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Any person who violates and refuses to obey any of the rules and regulations made, filed and adopted as set forth in Section 2.44.060 hereof, is guilty of a misdemeanor or shall be subject to the payment of a civil fine of up to \$100.00 pursuant to the issuance of an infraction whichever shall be specified in the rules and regulations which are certified, approved by the City Council and filed pursuant to said section. Infractions shall be assessed in the same manner as traffic infractions and shall be processed and fines paid in the manner set forth in Section 7(1), of Chapter 236, Laws of 1985, Regular Session, with fines assessed and recovered to be paid to the City."

CITY OF LACEY
PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are adopted, certified and approved as necessary for the government and control of parks, parkways, playgrounds or other recreational facilities owned, operated or used for recreational purposes by the City of Lacey.

- A. A person who commits any of the following acts within a park, parkway, playground or other recreational facility owned, operated or used for recreational purposes by the City of Lacey shall, pursuant to Section 2.44.060 and 2.44.070 of the Lacey Municipal Code be guilty of a misdemeanor:
1. Kills, or pursues with intent to kill, any bird or animal in any park or parkway.
 2. Willfully mutilates, damages, injures, defaces, or destroys any turf area, guidepost, notice, table, fence, enclosure, structure or facility of any park or parkway.
 3. Lights any fire upon any park or parkway, except in such places as the City has authorized, and willfully or carelessly permits any fire to spread or extend to any of the shrubbery, trees, timber, ornaments, or improvements upon any park or parkway.
- B. A person who commits any of the following acts within a park, parkway, playground, or other recreational facility owned, operated or used for recreational purposes by the City of Lacey shall, pursuant to Lacey Municipal Code Sections 2.44.060 and 2.44.070 be subject to a civil fine of up to \$100.00:
1. Cuts, breaks, injures, destroys, takes or removes any tree, shrub, timber, plants, or natural object in any park or parkway.
 2. Takes any fish from the waters of any park or parkway, except in conformity with such general rules and regulations of the City and/or Game Department.
 3. Places or affixes to any object within any park or parkway, any word, character, or device designed to advertise any business, profession, article, thing, exhibition, matter, or event without prior approval.
 4. Allows his or her animal or other pet into a prohibited area of a park. Provided, however, that such restrictions or prohibitions shall not apply to animals utilized by the visually or hearing impaired.

5. Operates a motor vehicle in other than designated roadways or parking areas.
6. Utilizes park facilities beyond standard park hours, which are 7:00 A.M. to dusk unless otherwise posted.
7. Consumes alcohol or utilizes controlled substances within any park or parkway.
8. Brings any firearm or weapon into any park or park facilities unless in conjunction with organized activities that have received prior approval.
9. Utilizes sound amplification systems within any park or parkway, without prior approval.
10. Swims in non-designated areas.
11. Deposits litter or household or commercial garbage within any City park, parkway or other City facility.
12. Launches or detonates any object within any park or parkway except in designated areas. Examples: Golf balls, model aircraft, rockets, fireworks, etc.
13. Solicits, sells, promotes or posts signs or circulars without prior approval.
14. Holds public or group rallies without prior approval.
15. Erects, maintains or occupies any temporary structure, tent, or shelter.
16. Brings an animal into a City park, parkway, structure or facility and does not remove feces deposited by the animal. The feces is to be placed in a plastic bag and deposited in a solid waste container.
17. Brings glass or metal containers onto any swimming beach. Exception: Soft drink cans with permanently affixed tab opener.


"Prior Approval" as used herein shall be only by the Director of Parks and Recreation or his designee.

- C. Persons committing those acts within subsection A of these rules and regulations which constitute misdemeanors pursuant to Section 2.44.060 and 2.44.070 of the Lacey Municipal Code shall be prosecuted by the City in the same manner as other violations of misdemeanor laws of the City. Persons committing those acts

listed within subsection B of these rules and regulations shall be subject to a fine of up to \$100.00 and notices of infraction shall be issued to said persons which infractions shall be assessed in the same manner as traffic infractions. Said infractions shall be processed and fines paid in the manner set forth in Section 7 (1) of Chapter 236, Laws of 1985, Regular Session, with fines assessed and recovered to be paid to the City.

Additional specific rules and regulations for the safe operation and maintenance of any park, parkway, playground or other recreational facility owned, operated or used for recreational purposes by the City of Lacey or for the conduct of recreational programs may be established by the Director of Parks and Recreation. The City shall have the authority to exclude any person or persons from current or future use of such facilities or programs on the basis of acts committed by said persons which are prohibited by the terms of the rules and regulations set forth herein or as may be so established.

The above stated park rules and regulations are hereby certified to be the true rules and regulations adopted by the Parks & Recreation Board to govern and control parks, parkways, playgrounds or other recreational facilities owned, operated or used for recreational purposes by the City of Lacey.
