

ORDINANCE 786
CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CERTAIN ACTS IN PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE CITY AND ADDING NEW SECTIONS TO THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby added to the Lacey Municipal Code a new section 9.16.050 to read as follows:

"(A.) It is unlawful for any person to urinate or defecate in a public place in the City of Lacey which is not specifically designated and intended for that use.

"(B.) For purposes of this section, the term 'public place' shall mean an area generally visible to public view and includes streets, sidewalks, bridges, alleys, plazas, parks, driveways, parking lots, buildings open to the public, and the doorways and entrances to buildings or dwellings and the grounds enclosing them."
