CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE BASIC SEWER SERVICE CHARGE TO PROVIDE FOR A RATE INCREASE SET BY THE LOTT SYSTEM AND TO PROVIDE FOR NECESSARY EXPENDITURES WITHIN THE CITY OF LACEY SEWERAGE SYSTEM AND AMENDING SECTIONS 13.16.060 AND 13.16.061 OF THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the basic sewer service charge for customers within the City of Lacey is currently set at the rate of \$13.35 per month per equivalent residential unit, which charge consists of \$8.85 per equivalent residential unit for construction and operation of the Lacey, Olympia, Tumwater and Thurston County (LOTT) Sewerage Treatment Facility, \$0.75 per equivalent residential unit to fulfill Lacey's contractual obligations to Olympia for the assumption by LOTT of the Olympia treatment facilities, \$2.75 per equivalent residential unit for the current maintenance and operation of the collection system of the City of Lacey, and \$1.00 to be reserved for the replacing, rebuilding and repairing of existing City of Lacey sewerage facilities; and

WHEREAS, the charges required by the LOTT agreement will be increased effective January 1, 1987, by the sum of \$1.80 to a total of \$10.65 per month; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary in order to provide for capital improvements, sewerage comprehensive planning and continued maintenance of the existing system including the televising of sewer lines that the rates for the Lacey sewerage collection system be increased by the sum of \$1.20 per month to a total of \$4.95 per month; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY,

WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Section 13.16.060 of the Lacey Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The 'basic sewer service charge' of Lacey shall be ~~\$13.35~~ \$16.35 per month per equivalent residential unit."

Section 2. Section 13.16.061 of the Lacey Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

~~"From-and-after-the-effective-date-of-the-ordinance codified-in-this-section-and-Section-13-16-060,-t~~ That portion of the basic sewer service charge levied for the purpose of replacing, rebuilding and repairing existing sewerage facilities, ~~-which-sum-is currently-in-the-amount-of-\$2.75-per-month-per-equivalent residential-unit,~~ shall be held in the water and sewer revenue fund in the restricted account for the purpose of replacing, rebuilding and repairing existing sewerage facilities of the city, and should the city council so determine, for the purpose of debt service requirements for any bond issue for sewerage facilities authorized ~~after-the-effective-date-of-the-ordinance-codified-in-this-section and-Section-13-16-060."~~
