



AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING EMERGENCY FUNDS FOR THE OFFICE OF THE BUILDING INSPECTOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY:

WHEREAS, the City of Lacey is a newly formed municipality having no previous budget upon which to make a proper forecast of expenditures and income for the year, 1967, and to forecast accurately a budget for the year, 1968, and said City was not incorporated on the first Monday in October of the year, 1966, as provided as the date for the final hearing on the adoption of budgets under the provisions of RCW 35.33.070, and

No. 69, on October 5, 1967, the expenditures for some departments were not adequately forecast, and it is imperative that the office of the Building Inspector be provided with the sum of \$100.00 in its Capital Outlay Classification and the sum of \$76.00 in its Employee Benefits Section of the Maintenance and Operation Classification, and there are adequate funds available in the Non-Departmental Section of the Maintenance and Operation Classification of the General Government Budget, and the use of said funds is necessary for the public health, safety and general welfare of the City of Lacey, and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists, Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY that \$176.00 be transferred from the Non-Departmental Section in the





Maintenance and Operations Classification of the General Government Budget to the Office of the Building Inspector as follows:

- 1. \$100.00 to the Capital Outlay Classification and
- 2. \$76 to the Employee Benefits Section of the Maintenance and Operations Classification,
