

ORDINANCE 810

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE RATE OF TAX UPON GAMBLING ACTIVITIES, PROVIDING FOR A TEMPORARY REDUCTION OF SAID TAX RATE AND CALLING FOR A STUDY OF COSTS INCURRED BY THE CITY IN ENFORCING THE GAMBLING LAWS OF THE STATE AND CITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Commencing September 1, 1987, and ending August 31, 1988, those certain taxes imposed upon the operation of bingo games and the utilization of punch boards and pull tabs within the City of Lacey by Section 3.06.010 of the Lacey Municipal Code shall be reduced from a rate of 5 percent calculated as set forth in said section to a rate of 4 percent as so calculated.

Section 2. Prior to August 31, 1988, the City Manager shall inform the Council of the costs incurred by the City and its various departments in enforcing the State and City gambling laws and recommend to the Council the appropriate rate of taxation upon such activities for the future.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be considered to be temporary in nature, and to the extent of its duration, shall amend those tax rates set forth in Section 3.06.010 of the Lacey Municipal

Code, but due to its temporary nature shall not be codified as a portion of said Code.
