SUMMARY FOR PUBLICATION ORDINANCE NO. 854

CITY OF LACEY

The City Council of the City of Lacey, Washington, passed, on May 11, 1989, Ordinance <u>159</u> entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING CODE OF THE CITY IN ORDER TO SPECIFY PARKING REQUIREMENTS APPROPRIATE FOR REGIONAL SHOPPING CENTERS BY AMENDING SECTION 16.72.030 E. 4. OF THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE."

A section by section summary of this Ordinance is as follows:

Section 1 amends Section 16.72.030 E. 4 of the Lacey Municipal Code to provide that the parking requirements applicable to regional shopping centers shall be four spaces per 1,000 square feet of gross floor area.

Section 2 approves this summary.
