

ORDINANCE NO. 937

CITY OF LACEY

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PET SHOPS, REMOVING THE SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS AND AMENDING SECTION 5.43.040 OF THE LACEY MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Section 5.43.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.43.040. Any building used for a pet shop shall meet the following requirements:

A. Animal housing shall be structurally sound and designed to prevent the pet animals from injury and shall provide sufficient security to contain the pet animals while preventing entry of unwanted pets.

B. The facilities shall include a washroom with sinks for hot and cold running water.

C. Heating, air cooling and shade shall be provided to protect the pet animals from temperatures to which they are not acclimated.

D. Adequate ventilation shall be provided.

~~E. ---A smoke and/or fire detection and alarm system shall be required, provided that any pet shop operating prior to adoption of~~

~~this ordinance in a location meeting building and fire codes shall have until April 30, 1992, to comply with this requirement.~~
