WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Lacey and its citizens that the proposed transportation program be adopted as the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program of the City of Lacey and that the City's Transportation Improvement Mitigation List be modified as proposed, NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that the document entitled 2020-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted as the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program of the City of Lacey and a copy of said plan together with a copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Department of Transportation of the State of Washington;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached 2019-2020 Transportation Improvement Mitigation List be adopted as the current Transportation Improvement Mitigation List designated as Table 14T-15 in Section 14.21.026 of the Lacey Municipal Code.
