CITY OF LACEY

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY EXTENDING THE PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION 1085 FINDING THAT THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) CONSTITUTES AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020 the Lacey City Council passed Resolution No. 1085 finding the COVID-19 outbreak to constitute an emergency; and

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2020 the Lacey City Council passed Resolution No. 1088 extending the provisions of Resolution 1085 until May 28, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2020 the Lacey City Council passed Resolution No. 1090 extending the provisions of Resolution 1085 until June 25, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2020 the Lacey City Council passed Resolution No. 1094 extending the provisions of Resolution 1085 until January 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2020 the Lacey City Council passed Resolution No. 1101 extending the provisions of Resolution 1085 until January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of City of Lacey Resolution No. 1101 will expire on January 1, 2022, unless further extended by formal action of the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Lacey City Council finds that the conditions constituting an emergency continue to exist and necessitate the extension of the provisions of Resolution No. 1085.

NOW THEREFORE, the Lacey City Council declares as follows:

Section 1. The provisions of Resolution 1085 are hereby extended and shall remain effective until January 1, 2023, unless sooner terminated or further extended by formal action of the Council.
