

RESOLUTION 243

CITY OF LACEY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 208 of the City of Lacey, an election was held in the City of Lacey on November 6, 1973 on the proposition that the City of Lacey adopt the classification of noncharter code city pursuant to Title 35A of the Revised Code of Washington and reorganize under the council-manager plan of government authorized by Chapter 35A.13 of the Revised Code of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the Thurston County Canvassing Board and the Thurston County Auditor have certified to the City Clerk the whole number of votes given at the election and the number of votes in favor of reclassification and reorganization under the council-manager plan of government and the number against it, and the number of votes received by each candidate and the City Clerk has laid said certification before the City Council of the City of Lacey on this 6th day of December, 1973 which is the next regular council meeting after his receipt of said certification; and

WHEREAS, it appears from said certification that the votes cast for adoption of the classification of noncharter code city and in favor of the council-manager plan of government were a majority of the votes cast in said election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The inhabitants of the City of Lacey have adopted the classification of noncharter code city pursuant to Title 35A of the Revised Code of Washington, and determined to reorganize under the council-manager plan of government authorized by Chapter 35A.13 of the Revised Code of Washington.

Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to file with the Secretary of State a certified copy of this resolution.
