
RESOLUTION AMENDING A LAND USE ELEMENT OF THE LACEY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the city council, by passage of Resolution No. 383, adopted the "Lacey Development Plan Land Use and Circulation Elements," and

WHEREAS, after public hearings, it has been recommended by the Planning Commission and determined by the city council that the Land Use Element of said Comprehensive Plan is in need of amendment; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL BY THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that the Land Use Element of that certain document entitled "Lacey Development Plan Land Use and Circulation Elements" as adopted by Resolution No. 383 of the City of Lacey, is hereby amended to change from Light Industrial/Commercial to Commercial that portion of the city described on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof as though fully set forth.

That portion of Section 16, Township 18 north, Range 1 West, W.M. lying southerly and easterly of the southerly right-of-way line of Primary State Highway No. 1 (as presently existing), northerly of the northerly right-of-way line of Martin Way (as presently existing), and westerly of a line beginning at a point on said northerly right-of-way line of Martin Way 460 feet west of the intersection of the eastline of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section 16 and the northerly right-of-way line of Martin Way, running north 20°00'00" West 1,453 feet, more or less, to the southerly right-of-way line of Primary State Highway No. 1.

The above containing 28.73 acres, more or less, and located in the City of Lacey, Thurston County, Washington.
