

RESOLUTION

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CITY OF LACEY

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 35.24.180, Ordinance No. 98 was passed on 25 SEPT. 1968 changing the meeting place for the City Council from the Lacey Fire Hall, City Hall, to the Lacey Lions Building at 1147 S. E. 43rd Street, Lacey, Washington, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Lacey Lions, a non-profit corporation, have agreed to rent said building to the City of Lacey on a month to month tenancy for fourteen (14) meetings per month (excluding the first and third Tuesdays of each month) so long as the City will provide janitorial services and its own liability insurance, and

WHEREAS, the agreed rental per month is SEVENTY-FIVE (\$75.00) DOLLARS with the Lacey Lions to pay for all utilities and said sum is reasonable, and

WHEREAS, because of crowded and inadequate conditions at the Lacey City Hall for the Council Meetings, Municipal Court and Planning Commission meetings, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Lacey that the mayor be authorized to rent said building, substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the rental agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein, Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY that the mayor rent from the Lacey Lions their building at 1147 S. E. 43rd Street, Lacey, Washington.
