A RESOLUTION AWARDING BID FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYSTEM AT COLLEGE STREET RAILROAD CROSSING UNDER FEDERAL AID PROJECT NO. RRP-0521 (1) CONTRACT NO. SA 0169 (PW 81-05)

WHEREAS, sealed bids for the furnishing and installation of a traffic signal system at the College Street railroad crossing were previously advertised for and were opened and read on May 1, 1981: and

WHEREAS, of all the bids submitted, the low bid was submitted by Electric Controls, Inc. in the sum of \$45,327.00 and said low bid has been examined and found to be legally acceptable and the Director of Public Works has recommended award of the bid to said low bidder; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that the contract for the furnishing and installation of a traffic signal system for the College Street railroad crossing under Federal Aid Project No. RRP-0521 (1) Contract No. SA 0169 be awarded to Electric Controls, Inc. for the sum of \$45,327.00, and the city manager is authorized to execute said contract on behalf of the City of Lacey.
