A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND AN AGREEMENT WITH CHEHALIS WESTERN RAILROAD FOR 21st AVENUE S.E. RAILROAD CROSSING SIGNALIZATION.

WHEREAS, the Chehalis Western Railroad crossing signalization on 21st Avenue S.E. in the City of Lacey is in need of updating and replacement with more modern equipment, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into an agreement with Chehalis Western Railroad Company for the labor and materials for the construction of such signalization, which contract will form the basis of an application for Federal Aid Safety Project funding, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into a supplemental agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for supplemental funding on said project, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that that certain railway agreement for Federal Aid Safety Projects Highway-Railway Grade Crossing Warning Devices between the City of Lacey and Chehalis Western Railroad Company for Project No. RRS-0645(3) and that certain agreement entitled Supplement No. 1 between the City of Lacey and the Washington State Department of Transportation known as State Agreement No. GC5846 are

both hereby approved and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Lacey.



The above parties having complied, or hereby agreeing to comply, with the terms and conditions set forth in (1) Title 23, U. S. Code, Highways, (2) The regulations issued pursuant thereto and (3) The Policies and Procedures promulgated by the Washington State Department of Transportation, relating to Grade Crossing Warning devices, hereby agree to proceed with the accomplishment and completion of the project herein after described.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

Install shoulder mounts and gates to replace present crossing protection.

Construction is estimated to be completed in 300 days, following execution of this agreement and authorization to proceed.

Where a Franchise or Permit exists, the parties shall determine to what extent the Franchise or Permit is superseded by this agreement. Such determination should be in writing and attached as part of the agreement.

REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF DAMAGED OR OBSOLETE SIGNALS. To the extent Federal, state or other public funds are not available for the purpose as provided in Section VI, hereof, the cost of repair or replacement of the signals shall be borne on the ration of 75 percent City/County and 25 percent Railway.

This agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding on the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.
