CITY OF LACEY

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF LACEY DEVELOPMENT GUIDELINES AND REPEALING RESOLUTION 304 RELATING TO INTERIM DESIGN STANDARDS

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to residents of the city, developers of property within the city, and administrative officials to set out in one document the requirements for the development of land within the city, and that certain document entitled "City of Lacey, Development Guidelines" has been prepared to accomplish this purpose, and

WHEREAS, there are certain design and development standards which have been encompassed as part of various documents and policies of the city and, because of their detail are impractical to set forth by ordinance, which standards are in need of formal adoption by the city and that certain document entitled "City of Lacey, Development Guidelines" sets forth such standards in a manner which can be officially adopted by the city, Now, Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That certain document entitled "City of Lacey, Development Guidelines" is hereby adopted by the City Council of the City of Lacey as a compilation of the requirements for land development within the city set forth in the various ordinances of the city and as the design and development standards of the City of


Lacey for those aspects of development not otherwise set forth in the city's ordinances.


