A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND BURLINGTON NORTHERN RAILROAD COMPANY FOR THE FRANZ STREET AT BURLINGTON NORTHERN RAILROAD CROSSING.

WHEREAS, the railroad crossing on Franz Street is in need of modification and signalization at said crossing is in need of updating and replacement with more modern equipment, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to enter into an agreement with Burlington Northern Railroad Company for the labor and materials for construction of such improved signalization, which contract will form the basis for the receipt and expenditure of Federal Aid Safety Project monies and, further, it is necessary to submit a petition to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for approval of said work; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that that certain City railway agreement for the Federal Aid Safety Project located at Franz Street at Burlington Northern Railroad crossing be approved and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Lacey and further, that the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Lacey the appropriate petition or petitions to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission

for authorization by said commission of the construction of said project.
