## A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE LAND USE ELEMENT OF THE LACEY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (FAITH ASSEMBLY OF LACEY)

WHEREAS, after public hearings it has been recommended by the planning commission and determined by the city council that the land use element of said comprehensive plan is in need of amendments; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that the land use element of that certain document entitled, "Lacey Development Plan Land Use and Circulation Elements," as adopted by Resolution No. 383 of the City of Lacey is hereby amended to change the following described real property from Low Density Residential to Open Space/Institutional with the environmentally sensitive overlay classification to remain for that portion located in the Southeast corner of said described property:

That part of the SW $1 / 4$ of the NE $1 / 4$ of Section 28 , Township 18 North, Range 1 West, W.M., described as lying northerly of the Wilcox Addition, as recorded in Volume 15 of Plats, page 51, southerly of 30 th Avenue S.E. easterly of Ruddell Road and westerly of a line described * as running $N 2^{\circ} 00^{\prime} 10^{\prime \prime} E$ from a point on the $S$ line of said NE 1/4, N $87^{\circ} 59^{\prime} 50^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} 1,673.16^{\prime}$ from its SE corner.
