

RESOLUTION 610

CITY OF LACEY

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, REQUESTING THE HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF LACEY ON APRIL 7, 1987, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS THOSE CERTAIN BONDING PROPOSITIONS SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE NO. 800 OF THE CITY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby found and declared that an emergency exists requiring the submission to the qualified electors of the city of Propositions 1 through 4 contained within Ordinance No. 800 of the City of Lacey.

Section 2. The Thurston County Auditor, as ex officio supervisor of elections in Thurston County, is hereby requested to also find the existence of such emergency and to call and to conduct a special election to be held within the city on April 7, 1987, and to submit to the qualified electors of the city the propositions set forth in Ordinance No. 800, a copy of which is attached hereto. It is further requested that the county auditor conduct said election by mail ballot pursuant to the provisions of RCW 29.36.120 through RCW 29.36.160 and that pursuant to said statutes, the auditor designate the county auditor's office or a central location in the city as the single place to obtain a replacement ballot. Further, that the county auditor also designate one or more places for the deposit of those ballots which are not returned by mail and that the place

or places designated be open on the date of the election, April 7, 1987, from the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.


