A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, REQUESTING THE HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF LACEY ON SEPTEMBER 15, 1987, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS THAT CERTAIN BOND PROPOSITION SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE NO. 805 OF THE CITY

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby found and declared that an emergency exists requiring the submission to the qualified electors of the city of that certain bond proposition contained within Ordinance No. 805 of the City of Lacey.

Section 2. The Thurston County Auditor, as ex officio supervisor of elections in Thurston County, is hereby requested to also find the existence of such emergency and to call and to conduct a special election to be held within the city on September 15, 1987, and to submit to the qualified electors of the city the proposition set forth in Ordinance No. 805, a copy of which is attached hereto.
